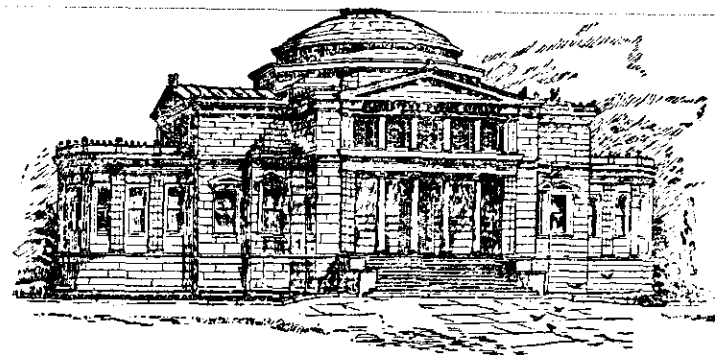

The above cut represents the Blackstone Memorial Library. It will be presented to the town of Branford by Mr. Timothy Blackstone of Chicago as a memorial of his father, Mr. James Blackstone, who was an honored and life long resident of Branford. Although some project of the kind had been often talked of in Branford, its first real inception dates from the efforts of Rev. M. K. Bailey, formerly rector of Trinity Church to found a reading room or center for the younger men of the town to assemble. This project, meeting with but slow financial response, a committee was formed, consisting of Mr. Alfred Hammer, Mr. Lester J. Nichols and Dr. C. W. Gaylord, to confer personally or by letter with several who having gone out from Branford might still have an interest in their native town and birthplace. Out of these negotiations developed the offer of a gift to the town of a free library building and library for same and the following were appointed by Mr. Timothy Blackstone to hold the same in trust for the benefit of the town: T. F. Hammer, Edward F. Jones, C. W. Gaylord, M. D., Edmund Zaehner, William Regan, Henry W. Hubbard, ex-officio, Addison Van Name, librarian of Yale.

The Library building is in the form of a Latin cross and is constructed of pink marble from Tennessee, the inside fittings being of the same material, while doors and railings are of solid bronze. The floors throughout are of mosaic, while the wall surfaces, rotunda, dome, etc., will be
