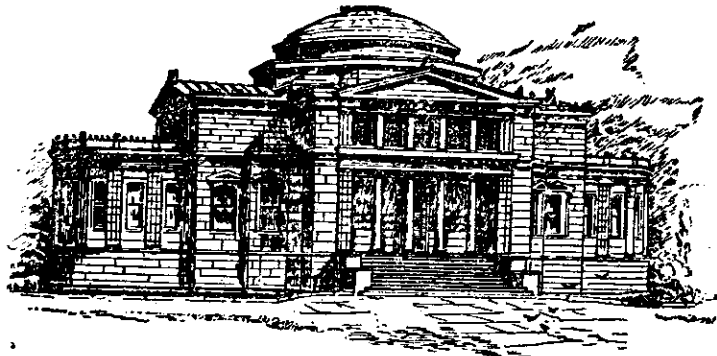

BLACKSTONE LIBRARY.

The above cut represents the Blackstone Memorial Library. It was presented to the town of Branford by Mr. Timothy B. Blackstone of Chicago, as a memorial of his father, Mr. James Blackstone, who was an honored and life long resident of Branford. Although some project of the kind had been often talked of in Branford, its first real inception dates from the efforts of Rev. M. K. Bailey, formerly rector of Trinity Church, to found a reading room or center for the younger men of the town to assemble. This project, meeting with but slow financial response, a committee was formed, consisting of Mr. Alfred E. Hammer, Mr. Lester J. Nichols and Dr. C. W. Gaylord, to confer personally or by letter with several who having gone out from Branford might still have an interest in their native town and birthplace. Out of these negotiations developed the offer of a gift to the town of a free library building and library.

The building is 160 feet long by 140 feet wide and consists of two stories and basement. In the basement are the gymnasium and bath rooms, the store rooms and the boilers and engine room, gas machines and electric light plant. On the first floor are the reading, students', catalogue and librarian's rooms, shelves for 20,000 books, and a lecture hall with stage and gallery. On the second floor are the reception, directors', retiring rooms, and art galleries.

The reading room is liberally supplied with the best literature of the day, and its use, together with that of the library, is free to all inhabitants of Branford.

A branch library and delivery station was opened at Stony Creek February 3, 1900.

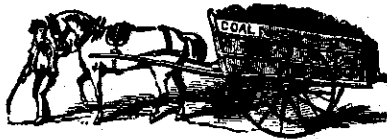

Bradford Directories.
