Branford Schools

There was an "old red schoolhouse" on the Green during the late 1700s to early 1800s about where the Academy is today.

- 1799- Mill Plain School, closed 1929, now a house
- 1800-1890 were several Stony Creek School locations
- 1820- The Academy
- 1845- Plantsville School, closed 1895, long gone
- 1846- Quarter School (Bradley Street), closed 1880s, now a house
- 1866- Center School, demolished 1939
- circa 1868- Paved Street School, closed 1929, a house, demolished 1985
- circa 1870- old Canoe Brook School about where Starbucks is today, closed 1898
- circa 1878- old Damascus School, closed 1929 and demolished
- 1878- old Harbor Street School, closed 1922, long gone
- 1879- old, old Short Beach School, moved and became a house in 1909
- 1893- Stony Creek School, closed 1981, now offices
- 1894- Laurel Street School, closed 1976, offices, demolished 1994
- 1898- Canoe Brook School, 1986 became Senior Center
- 1901- Hillside Avenue built as a fire house, school 1915-1928, police station 1932-1974, demolished 1993
- 1909- Old Short Beach School, closed 1972, now a house
- 1912- Saltonstall School, demolished 1941
- 1915- Brushy Plain School, closed 1929, now a house
- 1915- old Indian Neck School, now community groups

- 1917- Harrison Avenue, closed 1974, now community groups
- 1922- Harbor Street School, now Branford Counseling Center
- 1928- High School on Eades Street, now Sliney School
- 1949- New Short Beach School, now Orchard House
- 1950- New Indian Neck School
- 1955- Branford Hills School, was the twin of Pine Orchard School, torn down 2015
- 1958- Branford High School
- 1960- new Brushy Plain School now Murphy School
- 1960- new Damascus School, now Tisko School
- 1961- St. Marys School
- 1965- Branford Hall School of Business founded
- 1971- Wightwood School, closed about 2005, now vacant
- 1972- Intermediate School, now Walsh School
- 1974- Branford Early Learning Center founded as Branford Day Care Center, has had different locations
